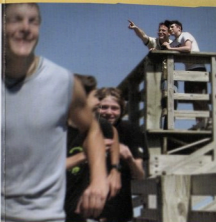

Laughing is not in short supply here. Having fun is essential. That's why our members are encouraged to participate in social activities that suit their interests.

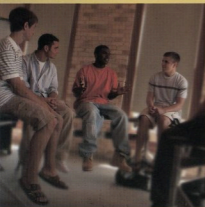


BEYOND FUN.
