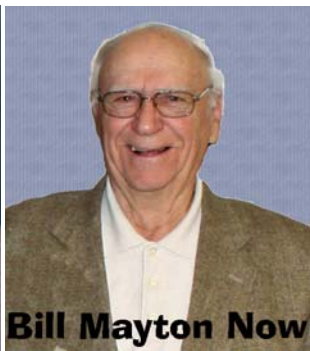


CONGRATULATIONS ON 50 YEARS AS A KNIGHT

Grand Knight's Message...

"A time to speak out"

To many, the Knights of Columbus is an archaic organization that simply is no longer relevant. Our earliest brethren organized under Father McGivney to stand up for the belief that you could be both American and Catholic. While the anti-Catholic sentiment of the 1880's has waned, our Catholic way of life remains under attack by those calling for unlimited abortion rights under the Freedom of Choice Act that has been introduced in Congress. The President supports this measure as does Senator Sherrod Brown, Democrat from Avon.

I will summarize for you the two salient features of the Act:

- Absolutely no restrictions under state law on abortions; and
- Doctors performing abortions are **prohibited** from providing nutrients or warmth to babies expelled alive from the womb as the result of a failed abortion.

A member of our Council has recently communicated with Senator Brown who enthusiastically voiced his support for this measure. Recent actions by the President clearly signal his support for the same.

While supporters of the Freedom of Choice Act hold themselves out as "defenders of the Constitution" and "champions of liberty" they in fact have become instruments for the propaganda of evil. They hope to delude others into believing that abortion is a right and is not the intentional taking of innocent human life.

It is our obligation as The Blessed Mother's Knights to speak for the unborn and defend the sanctity of life. In the coming weeks, our Council will begin a campaign to inform Senator Brown and other supporters of our opposition to the Freedom of Choice Act and abortion in general. I ask you to be an active and vocal participant in our upcoming pro-life campaign. Take courage and stand up for the Culture of Life. Do not lose hope and become discouraged for Truth always prevails and our Lord always triumphs.
